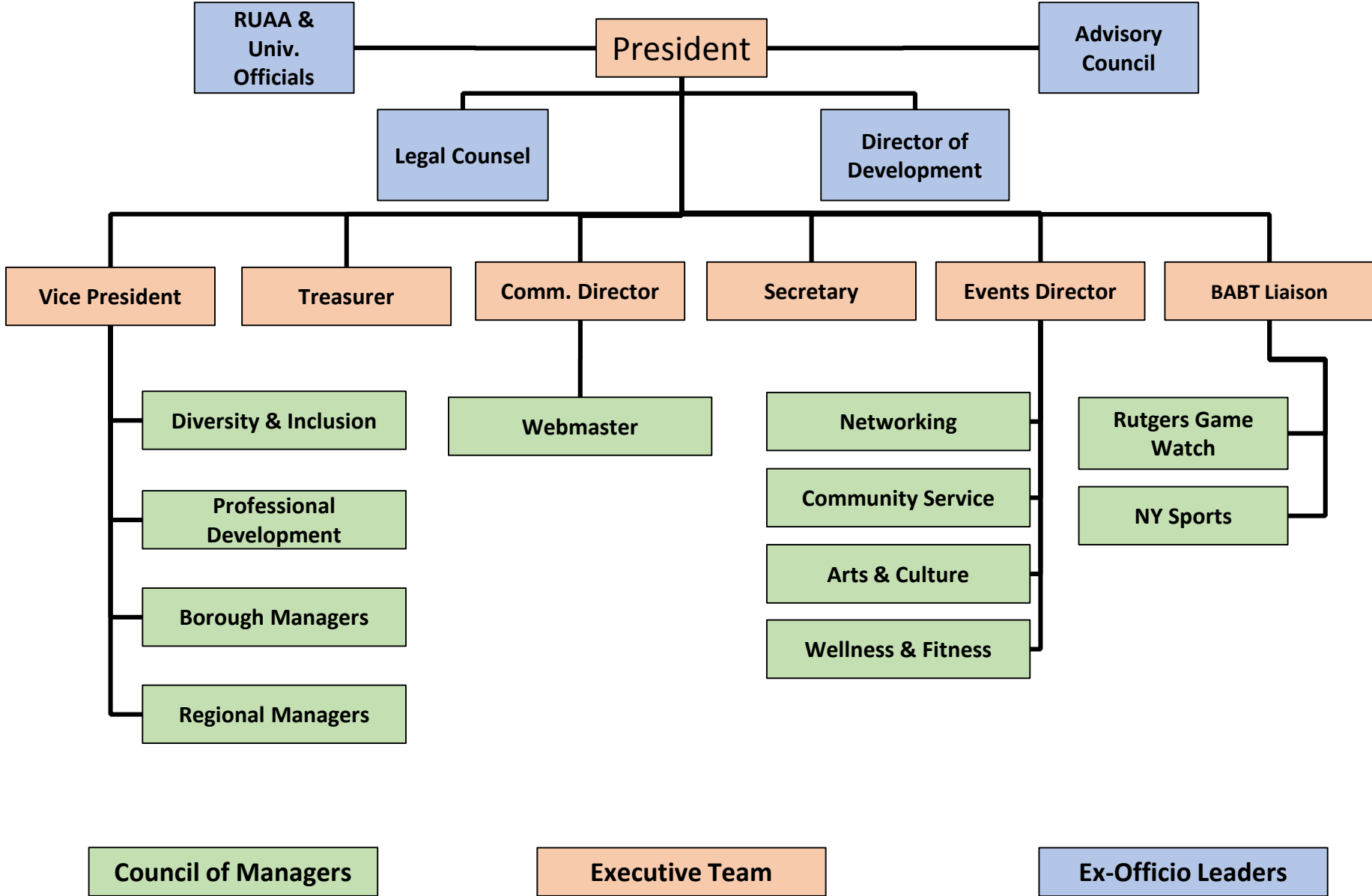

Article IV – The Board Section 1. Structure - The Board will consist of the Executive Officers, Council of Managers, and Ex-Officio Leaders. A. The Executive Officers (voting members) will consist of the President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Communication Director, Events Director, and Big Apple Big Ten Liaison. B. The Council of Managers (voting members) will consist of Program Managers, Event Managers, Borough Managers, Commuter Managers, Communication Managers, and Rutgers Game Watch Manager. C. The Ex-Officio Leaders (non-voting members) will consist of Legal Counsel, Immediate Past President, Director of Development, Club Advisory Council, and RUAA & University Officials.
